## Timeline Club

Last year the sixth grade class of 2006-2007 launched a project which we need volunteers to complete this year: the construction of a beautiful painted tile time line to extend the full length of buildings 2 and 3 (Classrooms 1-9) of Cornerstone Christian Academy. Graduating sixth graders met this summer to complete work on the twentieth century section of the timeline, and some are even interested in coming back to help in the completion of the project.
