Personal Volunteer Commitments

In this handbook we have established a volunteer commitment value on each available position. The following is a summary of the commitments estimated in this handbook:

Full Commitment	40+ hours per year
½ Commitment	20-40 hours per year
¼ Commitment	less than 20 hours per year

There are jobs that fulfill only a fraction of a full commitment to help those with limited time and availability the opportunity to volunteer as well. Further, there are jobs that can be done from home for those with small children, jobs and other circumstances that may limit availability from the “daytime” needs of the school. Although not all jobs are equal, we did our best to make the commitments fulfilled as consistent as possible. It is the underlying assumption that each family will fulfill a full commitment as a minimum.
