

## **Becoming a Cornerstone Board Member**

**Interested in becoming a CCA school Board Member?** That is great! This information will help you familiarize yourself with the requirements and guidelines needed to fulfill this role. The policies and arche' have been established so that you will fully understand CCA's philosophy and model it diligently each year.

### **Eligibility requirements:**

Most importantly to note is that one must be a member in good standing of Catalina Foothills Church, one of her daughter churches or newly allowed no more than 25% of the board make up may be non-CFC members to be eligible. Our school is a ministry of Catalina Foothills Church and reflects its doctrine as such. They are our leadership and we govern under their authority. There are other requirements that can be found in the School Board Policy Manual (2.330 and beyond). The term is a 3 year commitment.

The school board is a body that has many different parts. Each part is unique and can fulfill a necessary job required to smoothly run CCA. We try to seek out what is needed and what provides balance. A willingness to educate yourself is a must as a lot of outside reading is required so you can know exactly what CCA is about. That is what you will be asked to promote and defend if on the board.

We attempt to get a good blend of men and women on the board. We also have a member of CFC's session sit on the board as a full voting member and liaison between us & the church leadership. We need talents that range from financial, business-minded, development oriented, philosophy and educational oriented, as well as other skills. We seek those who have mature relationship with Christ and have the mindset to be unified even in a diverse body. This can be a challenge. We encourage lively discussion, then a vote; and the decision made is the one voice of the whole board. A humble spirit is required here.

We write this so you all will know that we are grateful for anyone who has the interest to sacrificially serve our covenant families as a Board Member at CCA. *Please do not feel turned away if your skills do not match what we need this year. We may be striving to strike a balance that will require a particular blend of people.*

Please let the current board president know if you feel led to apply for the board after reviewing the materials available in the school office. The deadline for such notification is the 1<sup>st</sup> of February. The current board members as well as CCA's Headmaster are always available for further discussion.
